

# Master of Music with Concentration in Conducting

## Admission Requirements

1. A Bachelor of Music degree or its equivalent.
2. Audition with a three-person panel of area faculty.
3. Completed application to the UTEP Graduate School (<https://www.utep.edu/graduate/apply-now/apply-now.html>) which includes official undergraduate transcript, two letters of recommendation, and statement of purpose.

There are three options available in this concentration, depending on the candidate's specialization: Wind Conducting, Choral Conducting, or Orchestral Conducting.
